Exercise 1: Core Commands

cd : **c**hange **d**irectory example: cd /home changes to home directory

Problem 1: change to directory "/bin"

mkdir: make directories

example: mkdir cop4530_homework makes directory cop4530_homework

Problem 2: Change to directory "~" and create directory "my_files"

ls: list directory contents

example: ls /bin

lists the contents of /bin folder.

Problem 3: list the directory contents of "~"

Do you see the folder you created named "my_files"?

man: an interface to the on-line reference **man**uals

example: man Is

Enter "q" to exit. Brings up the manual page for Is.

Problem 4: open the manual page for "cp", look around, and exit.

You can use "man <command name>" for all of the commands we cover except cd.
